

MODERN SLAVERY STATEMENT

This statement applies to JCURV Limited (the Company) in respect of the financial year ending 30 April 2023.

JCURV limited is a professional services firm offering clients advice and support to increase their agility.

The Company has a commitment to conducting business in a responsible way and in accordance with its employee handbook.

As a professional services provider, the Company does not operate in an industry where modern slavery is prevalent but nevertheless it is committed to taking steps to monitor any potential risks within its supply chain.
